ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Pal International Schools Australia Scholarship program is awarded to students who can demonstrate solid academic abilities as well as a willingness to learn and be prepared to contribute to the community. 2022 Scholarship entries are available for Years 6 and 10 local students only. Students are required to sit a scholarship exam followed by an interview. This scholarship will give students the privilege of studying and learning in our innovative paperless 4D learning environment.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships will only cover tuition fees. In order to continue receiving the scholarship, the student must maintain an average academic standard of 90% and adhere to the behaviour policy, which can be found in the Student Handbook. During the time of scholarship, if the student fails to meet these conditions, their scholarship will be reassessed. The scholarship is for a continuous enrolment period and ceases when the student withdraws from Pal International School Australia.

ELIGIBILITY

- Scholarship applicants must be a permanent resident or citizen of Cambodia.
- The student must show the family status and situation by providing the evidence of family conditions.
- Students in Year 2 to 10 in 2022 will be able to apply for scholarship entry to Year 3 to 11 in 2023.
- Students will be required to sit a Scholarship Examination in English. An interview with the principal maybe requested.

CONDITIONS

1. Academic Scholarship

Only for students who meet or exceed the school's academic standards.

The Academic Scholarship will award to the student who meet or exceed the school's academic standards and conditions, Smart student or outstanding student who completed the studying terms/course and received high score or rate of learning and follow the rule of school's standard conditions.

2. Financial Support Scholarship

Only for poor student from poor family in Cambodia who unable to effort to support their own children for English Education.

Financial Support will require important documents from student's family to verify the status of their children to receive financial Support scholarship.

The documents support for Financial Support Scholarships below,

- Poor Family Certificate issued by Chief of Commune.
- Home Visit
- Criminal Letter from court Or Police Station.
- Guarantee Letter from student Parents.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Along with the application, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Certified copy of the student's birth certificate
- If necessary, Pal International School Australia requires the right to request further documents to prove eligibility.
- Submission of a Personal Statement
- If the applicant is successful, the school will request an interview with the applicant

Before accepting the scholarship, you must read the Terms and Conditions and accept them by signing below. When you accept the scholarship, you are agreeing to abide by the Terms and Conditions and failure to do so may result in termination of the scholarship.

Scholarship Value

The scholarship will only cover tuition fees. The Education Services Levy fee and Excursions will need to be paid separately. The funds from the scholarship are not transferable, and cannot be redeemed for cash. Since the scholarship has been awarded to you at Pal International School Australia, it cannot be transferred to another school or student. The scholarship does not include transportation or lunch costs. The student awarded with the scholarship must accept responsibility for the payment to the school of the difference between the amount of the scholarship and the fee of the school charges for sporting activities, tablet and uniform.

Retaining Your Scholarship

In order to continue receiving the scholarship, you must adhere to the behaviour policy, uniform policy, maintain academic integrity and achieve a 90% average results every year. You should strive to maintain high standards in your academics, attendance, attitude and support the ethos of the School. As a scholarship holder, you are expected to attend and be actively involved in all school events and functions.

Cessation of Your Scholarship

As the scholarship holder, you are subject to all the rules and regulations of Pal International School Australia. This extends to the behaviour, academic honesty and uniform policy. Please keep in mind that the failure to disregard rules and regulations will result in termination of your scholarship.

The Education Services Fees are expected to be paid on time on a yearly basis. The failure to do so could result in termination of your scholarship.

If there is failure in performance in any of the areas specified above, you may be in jeopardy of losing your scholarship.

During the time of scholarship, if the student fails to meet the conditions specified above, their scholarship will be reassessed. The scholarship is for a continuous enrolment period and ceases when the student withdraws from Pal Buddhist School.
